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Lake Resia - Lake Garda

ALONG THE ADIGE CYCLE PATH TO LAKE GARDA.

This <u>tour along the Adige</u>, one of the longest rivers in <u>Italy</u>, impresses with a very special route. After the start, only a few kilometres after the Austrian border, the area becomes a bit more Mediterranean with every turn of the pedal. The unique natural scenery leads past lakes, through gorges, vineyards and enchanting cities to the largest lake in Italy – <u>Lake Garda</u>. Don't just enjoy the Italian 'Dolce Vita', walk in the footsteps of Reinhold Messner and meet Ötzi the Ice Man.

Details about the cycle tour Lake Resia - Lake Garda

The stage destinations of this tour read like a 'who's who' of Italian cultural highlights. On day 3 you roll down to Merano with a view of the mighty Ortler massif. Day 4 takes you to Bolzano, where wine, pasta and pizza taste even more delicious in front of the imposing mountain backdrop. Be it a shopping spree or historical voyage of discovery – you should definitely explore the alleys and arcades of the old town.

Accompanied by orchard and grapevines you continue to Trento, where the beauty of the architecture will take your breath away – there's a reason why it's also known as the 'painted city'.

Highlights of the 7-day cycle tour Lake Resia – Lake Garda


- Magnificent panorama of the Ortler: The Ortler summit reaches 3,905 metres and is a popular
 destination for alpinists. Passing castles and palaces, on the way to Merano you can also enjoy a
 great panoramic view of the mountain range 'from below'.
- South Tyrolean wine and fruit in the Vinschgau: Apple orchards, apricot cultivation and grapevines
 characterise this climatically unusual area in <u>South Tyrol</u>. Whether Vernatsch, Pinot Blanco or
 Gewürztraminer taste the fine wines where they grow.

- The spa town of Merano: The air is pure! Merano is considered to be a climatic health resort. A visit to the thermal baths or the botanical gardens at Trauttmansdorff Castle brings pure relaxation.
- The Lake Garda towns of Torbole and Riva: Limoncello or cappuccino? You can enjoy both at your
 destination! There is a lot to discover. In the past Torbole was considered a fishing and lumberjack
 village, that has changed today it is a Mecca for surfers and sailors! Meanwhile, in the
 glamorous Riva del Garda you can stroll and soak up the Italian way of life.

Useful information about the cycle tour Lake Resia – Lake Garda

Although there are some small inclines to master, this tour is 1,500 metres downhill and is therefore suitable for every cyclists – the tour is also available for <u>families</u>. In addition, the <u>Adige cycle paths</u> are really great.

Arrival in Resia/surroundings

In the evening, you have a personal tour information and the handover of rental bikes.

Resia/surroundings – Silandro

approx. 45 km

Today you will cycle along Lake Resia with a great view of the sunken church of Graun until you reach the medieval village of Glurns (perfectly preserved medieval city walls). Your destination is Silandro, the capital of the famous Vinschgauer.

Sample hotel: Goldene Rose



Silandro – Merano

approx. 40 km

On your way you will come across some pretty castles (mountaineer Reinhold Messner's castle Juval) and you will get marvellous views of the impressive mountain massif Ortlermassiv and the mountain pass Stilfserjoch while you are rolling down on your bike into the tranquil Merano with its Mediterranean vegetation.

Sample hotel: Villa Laurus



Merano – Bolzano

approx. 30/45 km

Two paths lead to Bolzano: One along the Adige River and another through the impressive landscape of orchards via Lana and Eppan. Here you can find the Messner Mountain Museum in the well-restored ruin of Sigmundskron. Ötzi – the man from the ice – is worth a visit.

Sample hotel: Mondschein



Bolzano – Trento approx. 70 km

From Bolzano, you will cycle along the river Isarco and later along the river Adige on a beautiful bike path that is rich with orchards to Salorno, where the German speaking part of South Tyrol ends and afterwards to the historic centre of Trento accompanied by the vineyards of "Teroldego" vines.

Sample hotel: NH Trento



Trento- Torbole/Riva

approx. 50 km

Today, you will cycle on bike paths along the river Adige via the old Tyrolean border town of Rovereto to Mori. From here, the route leads westward to Lake Garda. After a short climb onto Passo S. Giovanni (150 metres) you will head down to the lake and Torbole, Riva, or Arco.

Sample hotel: Corallo



Departure or extension

Tour character

You will cycle on beautiful bike paths mainly along the Adige River. The route will lead you from the Reschenpass (mountain pass) almost 1,500 metres in altitude downhill to Lake Garda. However, you will have to cycle some small climbs too. Overall, you will find yourself on beautiful bike paths and country lanes. Unfortunately, moderate traffic is unavoidable on some short connecting roads.
